Five things for a seed to flourish:

1. soil
 - the good soil of your heart (Matthew 13)
2. light
 - The Word of God is a lamp unto your feet, a light to your path (Psalm 119:105)
3. water
 - Jesus is the living water who washes and renews your soul (John 7:37-38)
4. temperature
 - The fire of the Holy Spirit warms the seed planted in your heart (Luke 3:16)
5. time
 - John 3:16-18
