Week 1: Got Fruit?

Scripture: Colossians 1:1-14

“Have they fruit?” - John Wesley

Verse 4: Faith and love flow from \_\_\_\_\_

Hope from God empowered the Colossians to \_\_\_\_\_ live toward that future.

The gospel is not just a report of something that God did in the past (“Jesus died for our sins back there”) but a \_\_\_\_\_ that is \_\_\_\_\_ toward the future, a hope that \_\_\_\_\_ the way people live here and now.
