



## Come and See

**Scripture:** John 1:29-42

A Pattern Develops:

In order for us to see God among us, we have to be

“What do you want?” (v38)

Greek verb \_\_\_\_\_ which means “abide, remain, endure, continue, dwell, in the sense of permanence or stability.”

**Start talking.**

**Start thinking.**

- What do you think John the Baptist meant by calling Jesus the “Lamb of God”? “Son of God”? What proof supports these titles?
- In light of vv30-31, how do you think John felt when his disciples left him to follow Jesus?
- What do you believe motivated John’s disciples to follow Jesus? For Andrew to share with his brother about Jesus?

**Start sharing.**

- What is your goal? What are you looking for/seeking?
- Of the titles used so far which ones mean the most to you?

**Start praying.** *Be bold and pray with power.*

*God, I’m seeking and I believe that you’re inviting me to abide, to live into your life. Help me to accept that invitation and to know that it requires all of me. Help me completely surrender to your love. Help me to rely on the grace that you give and to allow it to change me.*

**Start doing.** *Commit to a step and live it out this week.*

- Pray daily for God to reveal Himself to you and one other person you choose to pray for.
- Start living obediently within a world that is consumed in the selfishness, and allow God to use you to show others God’s love.
