Start talking.

- When the mail comes, what do you open and read first?
- When you buy clothes, are you more interested in low price or high quality?

Start thinking.

- What do the context of the quotes (Mal 3:1; Isa 40:3) teach about the coming one?
- Why is John's ministry so popular (vv4-5)?
- What does John's clothing and diet say about him (v6)?
- Given John's message (vv7-8), what type of person is the crowd anticipating? How do these expectations account for the crowd's reception of John, despite his hard message?
- What do you think the dove and the voice (v10-11) meant to Jesus as he came out of the water? As he entered the wilderness? During his temptations? How would all this prepare him?

Start sharing.

- What from your life illustrates what it means to repent?
- When did Jesus Christ become more than just a religious figures or "cuss word" to you?
- What "spiritual wilderness" has God sent you into? How has that confirmed his love or mission?

Start praying. Be bold and pray with power.
