- Why wouldn't the Eleven believe them? What must be going through Peter's mind?

Start sharing.

- How did the meaning of the resurrection first "dawn" upon you?
 What difference does the resurrection make to you?
- Where is your spiritual life focused these days: On Good Friday? Easter Sunday? Or in between??

Start praying. Be bold and pray with power.

I realize that just like sometimes doubt can come up in my life counter to what you already have told me in your word. Help me to remember your Word. Help me to investigate where I find unbelief, to search your truth, and when I find it to share it with others. Help me to claim the truth that we declare as the Gospel, that you are risen indeed.
