- What are ways that our local church or small group can engage in new ways of loving our neighborhood?

### Start sharing.

- Define the term "holy" in your own words.
  How did this section of the prayer change your thoughts on holiness?
- What questions do you have about holiness and how the people of God might live holy lives in the world?
- What is your response when you hear Jesus say in Matthew 5:48, "Be perfect, therefore, as your heavenly Father is perfect"?
- How can we possibly achieve perfection like our heavenly Father?
