Sanctuary Update

Our main facility, including the sanctuary, is over 43 years old, and as with all things, they wear out. So we are confronted with an aging facility that is needing some updates.

What began in 2014 with a simple lighting upgrade in the sanctuary has slowly progressed. Along with much needed repairs, we've slowly done our best to upgrade, refresh and improve our facilities, with many projects saving the church money through energy conservation. All of this has been done with **no debt incurred** thanks to your generosity.

To date we've completed several phases:

- all chandeliers in sanctuary equipped with LED bulbs
- new sound and video system
- west half of building's windows replaced
- new platform LED lighting
- replaced platform carpet and added accessible ramps

Next we'll soon be upgrading our sanctuary windows to help with efficiency and light.

The big hurdle that we now face is that our final phases are best completed together. Our carpet in the sanctuary and foyer is in dire need to be replaced, with many seams becoming tripping hazards. Many of our pews are worn, and even broken in places. And finally, our ceiling needs to be painted because of age and where there is water damage.

Currently we have almost \$100,000 set aside through good stewardship and special gifts, but the remainder will require around an additional \$80,000. Would you pray about how you can be a part of the investment in our facilities not only for us, but for the future of our ministry in Baker City?
